Parishioners' Open Session

A draft copy of the Parish Councils proposed response has been available to view on the PC website and copies were distributed at the beginning of this meeting.

During the open session a number of comments were made by Parishioners.

In summary-

This is currently a call for sites and there are no Planning Applications to be considered.

There were questions raised about the impact on the Village if one or more sites became a Planning proposal. There are inaccuracies in the document as Hilton does not have a Dr surgery or a school. There is currently no infrastructure within the village to support further development and there are no employment opportunities. There were further concerns regarding the environment, extra vehicles on the road and air pollution.

Hilton Village Design Statement (VDS) is still current and sanctioned by HDC.

At the end of the open session the PC asked the audience whether they were in support of the response drafted by the PC. A vote was taken and it was unanimously voted to support the PCs response.

2. Discuss and decide on comments to be submitted to Huntingdonshire District Council regarding Housing and Economic Land Availability Assessment.

After discussion it was decided to make some small additions to the draft response.

It was proposed to submit the Parish Councils response to Huntingdonshire District Council on the HELAA consultation as proposed and voted by the majority of people attending the extraordinary meeting on the 30th October subject to small changes in opening and closing remarks.
